Tickets are limited, so don't miss out on this groovy evening! Gather your friends, wear your best disco shoes, and join us in making a difference.











Health Hub

Did you know that 73.4% of out-of-hospital cardiac arrests happen at home? Starting CPR immediately can double or even triple the chances of survival. Be sure the person is lying on a hard surface—move them to the floor if needed—before beginning chest compressions to ensure effectiveness.
